

Adaptations in school

Classroom organisation

- All desks in rows against the outside walls with an aisle down the middle
- Teachers desks at right angles to wall to enable full view of class
- All children own set of pencils crayons in trays
- Water bottles on desks and washed on a Friday by TAs
