Year 2

have had a fantastic end to the year. In English we have been writing instructions for what to do if you get lost. In maths we have been consolidating all our learning from the whole year, please keep practising on TTRS over the summer. This term we have also been doing lots of art. We started by looking at African Batik fabric., we have all designed our own design and used melted wax and a tjanting to put our design onto some fabric. We have also been looking at an Austrian artist called Hunderwasser.

Reflections from KS2

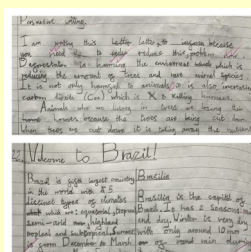
Year 5

The children have also completed their study of Ancient Greece which was celebrated by planning and cooking our own Ancient Greek feast! We thoroughly enjoyed taking part in our annual swimming gala and sports day and were all fantastic team players. As our time together



in Y5 comes to a close, we look forward to our Year 6 journey. **Year 4** have had a brilliant final half term! We have spent a lot of our lesson time

learning about Brazil and the Amazon Rainforest. Our text in English was "The Great Kapok Tree" which we have thoroughly enjoyed. It has given us opportunities to write our own story ending, non-chronological reports about deforestation and the Amazon rainforest, poetry and persuasive arguments. We have linked our Geography with this and studied Brazil, finding out what it is like to live there. In Science, our knowledge of rainforests has come in useful, as



we have looked at the habitats and organisms that live there. In Maths, we have learnt about angles, symmetry, position

Since then, we have been finishing the year by writing autobiographies that will be displayed for all to see at the Leavers Assembly. In Geography, we have loved
